This is a vintage Anatolian hallway rug. A Turkish, woven carpet or wall covering, dating to the late 20th century, circa 1970.

- Deep colours and fine detail
- Displaying a desirable aged patina
- Woven wool carpet of high quality
- Pink and beige hues against a dark blue ground, providing great contrast
- Central diamond motif plays host to a mirrored geometric scene
- To each end, posies of flower heads add further visual interest
  - Tramline borders of cream with repeating foliate pattern, with smaller diamond borders to the sides
- Light cream tassels to both ends in very good order
- The reverse reveals a predominantly red palette to the woven decorations

This is a quality vintage Anatolian hallway rug, with great colour and soft woollen feel underfoot. Perfectly sized for the centre of a room or within a reception hall. Delivered ready to lay.
