- Unmarked shield to the front ideal for family crest or monogram engraving
- 6 compartments dutifully hold each of the condiments vessels
- Each resplendent in quality, clear glass with silver plated collars
- Pair of shakers for salt and pepper respectively
- Three spirit vessels replete with eye-catching cut glass stoppers
- Mustard or similar condiment caddy with silver plated spoon
- The spoon hallmarked 'Amnora - A S B' for Adolph Scott of Birmingham
- Hallmarks to base of rack reading 'R, P, Crossed Swords, L, EP and EPNS' for Robert Pringle and Sons
