This is an antique court cabinet. An English, oak sideboard or credenza in Jacobean revival taste, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1890.

- Impressive cabinet with fine carved details
- Displaying a desirable aged patina
- Select oak shows fine grain interest with delightful wisps of medullary rays
- Rich caramel and russet hues beam beneath the wax polish finish
- Upper valance hosts a wide opening drawer, decorated with a scrolled frieze pattern
- Pair of acanthus bulb supports with dashing petal carvings to each side
- The lower arrangement of four cabinet doors intersected by two wide drawers at the mid-point
 - Upper doors dressed with a pair of shield lock escutcheons over working locks – keys present
- Overall carved appearance and solid proportions key to the Victorian fascination with the Jacobean taste
- Pleasingly unusual carved male figure located between the upper cabinet doors
- Copious carved panels with shell carvings, foliate patera et al adding further visual interest
