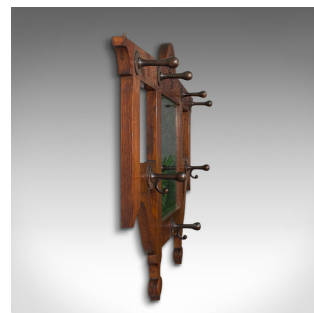
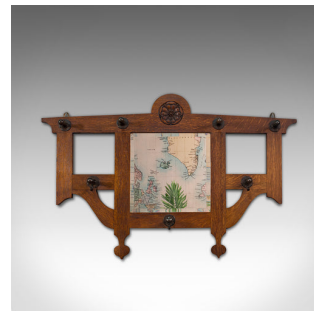


Antique Hall Mirror, Scottish, Valet, After Mackintosh, Arts & Crafts, Victorian

- Dressed with seven useful hooks for hats, scarves and coats
- Pair of small brass loops for wall mounting
