This is a superb pair of antique drawing room elbow chairs. An English, walnut armchair or lounge seat, dating to the late Georgian period, circa 1820.

- Carved elbow chairs of exquisite quality and finish
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Select walnut offers rich caramel hues and fine grain interest
- Benefiting from a recent professional reupholster in tasteful silk cotton
- Upholstered seat back and traditionally stuffed base with a deep over cushion can be removed for a lower seat height
- Serpentine elbows tease gracefully from back to front with scrolled knuckles and carved details
- Golden weave over natural cream ground to the silk cotton seat coverings with delightful flower pattern
 - Beautifully finished underside to cushions in a citrus yellow hue
 - Canted C-scroll knees with beading finish beneath square cut supports
 - Striking scroll front apron with pierced fretwork decor unites the pair of front legs
 - \bullet Gently splayed rear legs host a pair of squat balusters with gently shaped feet
