This is an antique decorative lighthouse. An English, Cornish Serpentine marble ornament, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Charming lighthouse ornament with English coastal appeal
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Red serpentine marble native to south west Cornwall, the markings redolent of mottled snake skin
- The base presented in the natural finish of the source material, from the Lizard, Britain's most southerly point
 - In the form of Wolf Rock lighthouse, located 9.2 miles (15km) from Land's End
 - The lighthouse was built in the 1860s and weighs some 3000 tones

This is a superb antique decorative lighthouse, native to Cornwall with superb serpentine marble colour and interest. Delivered polished and ready to display.
