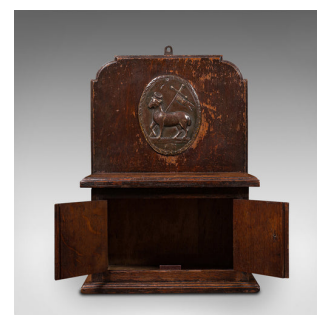


Antique Hanging Court Box, English, Oak, Middle Temple, London, Victorian, 1900

This is an antique hanging court box. An English, oak and brass key box with an emblem for The Honourable Society of Middle Temple London, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Wisps of medullary rays add distinction
- Weathered bronze emblem with the 'Lamb of God' motif carrying the flag of St. George

- Pair of doors to base, opening with a small brass pull
- Can be displayed as free standing or wall mounted with small hanging loop to rear
