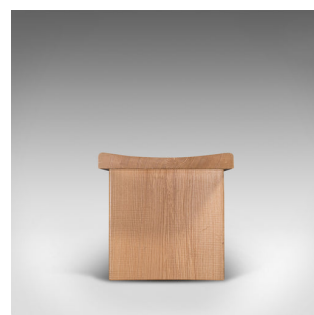
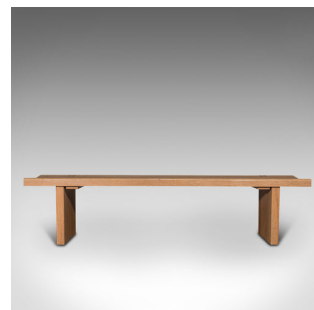


Pair Of Vintage Museum Benches, English, Oak, Dining, Kitchen, Pew, Circa 1980

This is a pair of vintage museum benches. An English, oak dining or kitchen pew, dating to the late 20th century, circa 1980.

- Appealing vintage form and of generous proportion at 6' wide
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and in good original order throughout
- Light English oak radiates mellow blonde hues beneath a wax polish finish
- Offering fine grain interest with quarter-cut figuring to the shaped ends
- Pleasingly substantial and solid - originally crafted for commercial museum use
- Thick bench top with an attractive concave finish, rising to offer under thigh support
- Detailed mortise and tenon joints with bands of contrasting finish
- Raised upon a pair of shaped stile legs with gently splayed appearance

This is a versatile pair of vintage museum benches, offering comfortable proportions for the dining table or for an institution. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready to enjoy.
