This is a vintage Ernst Leitz Microscope. A German, enamel coated alloy Dialux scientific instrument, dating to the mid 20th century, circa 1960.

- Built to a standard not seen in the modern era and with myriad accessories
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and in very good order objectives untested
- Finished in a quality black enamel over an alloy body
- Mahogany carry case with carry handle arranged with accessory slots to the interior
- Case door dressed with an inset, working lock original Leitz key present
- The trinocular head offers 1.25 magnification and marked 'Ernst Leitz, GmbH, Wetzlar Germany'
- Above the slide stage, the trio of objectives display a quality machined finish, as do the vernier controls
 - \bullet To the sinuous swan neck, the Leitz logo sits above the serial number 513724
 - Single circular lamp housing port to the base dates the piece to slightly before 1960
 - Offering a comprehensive set of 17 individual optics, by Leitz, Vickers and Beck
 - Four additional attachments a hallmark of this epoch making modular microscope
