This is a large antique breakfront sideboard. An English, mahogany and flame mahogany cabinet, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1850.

- Superb Victorian craftsmanship with striking grain
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Flame mahogany offers alluring grain interest beneath a wax polish finish
- Mahogany top sun-kissed with mellow caramel hues
- Trio of attractive ovolo shaped drawers with blind pulls sit above four cabinet doors
- Each drawer with deep fascia over oak boxes with dovetail joints
- \bullet Flame mahogany doors with field panels, the central pair dressed with small, circular brass pulls
 - Inset brass-lined locks to the outer doors untested, with key absent
 - Central cabinet arranged with a useful single shelf
 - To the breakfront outer cabinets, the left cabinet hosts a pair of shelves
 - On the right hand side, a useful drawer of deep proportion
