This is an antique wardrobe. An English, pitch pine closet with bevelled dressing mirror, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Extravagant figuring presents a highly distinctive appeal

- Pitch Pine shows copious grain interest and deep caramel hues
- Original mirror plate with desirable light foxing and clear reflective image
- Generously sized wardrobe access over a deep, wide drawer
- Door dressed with a shaped brass escutcheon with inset lock – key absent
- Quality bevelled mirror presented at an ideal height for dressing
- Interior fitted with brass hanging rail and a suite of useful hooks
- Drawer finished with a pair of brass drop handles over scallop shell backs
- The drawer boxes exude quality with multiple dovetail joints
- Maker's mark to the reverse of the door - Oetzmans & Co, London
