This is an antique writing desk. An English, burr walnut and oak lowboy or table, dating to the Georgian period, circa 1800.

- Captivatingly figured and of superb elegance
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in fine antique order
- Burr walnut stocks graced with fine grain interest
- Rich caramel hues radiate beneath a quality wax polish finish
- Classical lowboy form with an arrangement of three drawers
- Bookmatched burr walnut top presents arresting figuring with inlaid border to edges
- Drawer fronts finished with brass drop handles over bat wing backplates
- Inset lock with escutcheon to central drawer — key absent
- Oak drawer boxes with large dovetail joints exude quality craftsmanship
- Dashing front apron with sinuous shaped brackets cascading to the broad knee
- Raised upon a tall quartet of serpentine cabriole legs with broad pad feet
