This is an antique decorative condiment set. An English, sterling silver boxed set by Henry Matthews of Birmingham, hallmarked in the Edwardian period, dated 1909.

- A fine set, presented wonderfully within the original quality case

- Sterling silver shines brightly with decades of gently polished finish
- Striking blue glass inserts show the deepest cobalt hues
- Encased within quality English oak, showing rich caramel hues and fine grain interest

  - Dressed in dark blue velvet, each condiment pot sits within a shaped enclosure
  - $\bullet$  Each of the five spoons held in place with small elastic hoops

  - Mustard pot offers a hinged lid with spoon recess and blue glass interior
