This is a vintage designer coffee table. A Dutch, slate and brass brutalist artwork from the Tableaux series by Paul Kingma, dating to the late 20th century, circa 1980.

Paul Kingma (1931 - 2013) was a Dutch mosaic artist with a love of Brutalist design, which was a hallmark of his furniture from the 1970s and onwards. During the following decade, Kingma accentuated his 'Tableaux' series with found materials such as fossilised wood and coins. A student of art schools in The Netherlands and London, each piece is a one of one example – Kingma once claimed that his next table was going to be the most beautiful.

This is a superb vintage designer coffee table, one to delight collector's of Kingma's work or to decorate a feature room in a home or institution. Pleasingly heavy from the material used, this ...
