This is an antique partners desk. An English, mahogany and leather writing table, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Strikingly presentable partner's desk with twin pedestal form
- Displaying a desirable aged patina throughout
- Select mahogany shows fine grain interest
- Deep russet hues beam beneath a quality wax polish interest
- Wide inset leather skiver accentuates the top in a wonderful chestnut hue
- Pleasing blind tooling decorates the skiver border
- Arrangement of nine drawers to the front, each dressed with brass drop handles
- Inset brass locks to each drawer — key present, operates the top three drawers
- Stout top sits upon the two pedestals in a campaign manner
- Fully finished back affords ideal central room placement
- Standing upon deep plinth feet to each pedestal
