This is an antique carved court cabinet. An English, oak sideboard in Jacobean revival taste, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Superb craftsmanship paying homage to the grand Jacobean tradition
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Select oak shows fine grain interest throughout
- Deep caramel hues presented beneath a wax polish finish
- Gallery upper hosts a distinctive crown top over a canted cabinet
- Adorned with leaf carvings, the crown hosts a hidden compartment to the right-hand ide
- Bulbous carved pilasters stand prominently ahead of line fold carved panels
- \bullet Upper cabinet door with decorative carved frieze dressed with inset working lock key present
- Lower arranged as a pair of drawers over two cupboard doors with dashing butterfly hinges
- \bullet Portcullis motif accentuates the door fronts, with small wooden pulls and working locks key present
 - Distinctive decorative fluting panels to drawer fronts with circular pulls for access
