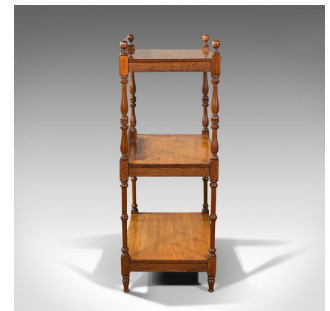


Antique 3 Tier Whatnot, English, Mahogany, Buffet, Display Stand, Victorian
