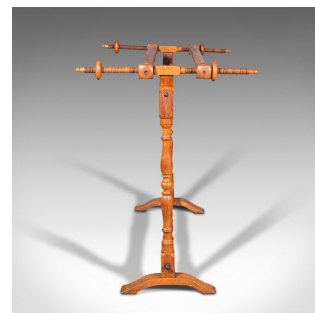


Antique Tapestry Stretcher, English, Beech, Needlepoint Frame, Victorian, 1900

This is an antique tapestry stretcher. An English, beech adjustable needlepoint frame, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Adjustable stretcher frame suitable for seated or standing use
- Displaying a desirable aged patina throughout
- Select beech shows fine grain interest and light caramel hues
- Articulated capping reveals a suite of tapestry pins to either end
- Tapestry frame with adjustment along the horizontal plane
- The frame rotating to standing or seated positions
- Lower stretcher rail with turned baluster carvings
- Raised upon two pairs of slipper feet, arched to the middle

This is a charming antique needlepoint stretcher, offering appeal for those of a traditional, creative taste or as a decorative piece. Delivered waxed, polished and ready to be enjoyed.
