This is an antique gentleman's wardrobe. An English, walnut compactum cupboard by Waring & Dillow, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Superior proportion and appearance
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Select walnut shows fine grain interest and deep caramel hues
- Quality bevelled mirror plates to doors, with desirable light foxing
- Central cabinet over four drawers with wardrobe doors to either side
- Upper cabinet doors decorated with foliate carved field panels
- Sliding drawers to the interior for smaller garments or shoes
- \bullet Each door dressed with brass lock escutcheons displaying figural masques keys absent
 - Drawers open smoothly by way of brass drop handles over ornate masque backplates
 - Dressed wardrobe interiors present a suite of brass hanging hooks
 - Internal drawer with half dome cup handles to the left hand wardrobe
