This is a large antique steamer trunk. An English, pine and iron travel or shipping chest, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Stout of build and antique visual appeal
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Pine stocks show mellow caramel hues and natural finish
- Rigorously bound with cast iron straps, ideal for voyage
- The braced lid opens smoothly, resting upon its internal stay
- Generous interior space presented with original weathering
- Dressed with a central iron latch over a maker's plate for J. Burton & Bro
- Large brass clasps to either side with engraved B.B. monogram – covered locks, key absent
- Travel labels adorn the exterior, adding character to the whole
- Decorative studwork across the lid, each engraved with a B
- Thick leather straps to each end aids carriage
