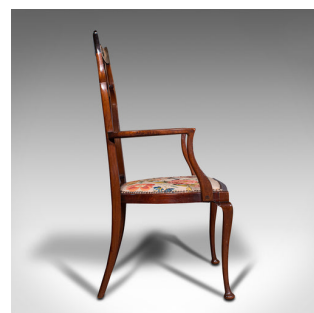


Antique Elbow Chair, English, Occasional, Art Nouveau, Libertyesque, Victorian
