Simple and elegant, this modestly designed chamberstick features the original push fit sconce atop the cupped candle column, all sitting within a generously dished wax pan with ridged edge detail. The typical pointed snuffer, terminating with a bead, is hosted neatly onto the 'C' scrolled handle that is decorated with a fern leaf detail that lips up for steady handling. The desirable aged finish of the plating testament to its age and use. The underside carrying the plating marks; "1901, A1, RR, Warranted Hard Soldered, 1525"
