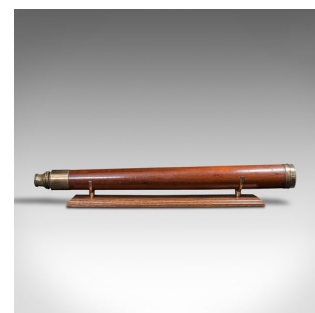
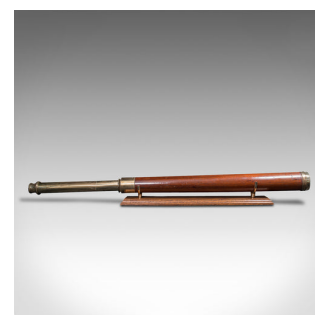
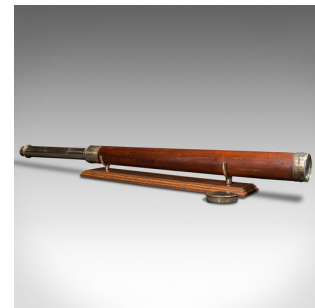


Antique Officer of the Watch Telescope, English, Terrestrial, Spencer Browning
