- Quality wax polish finish applied throughout
- Striking pierced fretwork with lyre shaped motif accentuate the rack
- Rolled handles to each end unite the sections with turned baluster rails
- Useful drawer to base adds further storage, dressed with decorative circular brass pulls
- Raised upon squat, turned legs and riding smoothly upon brass castors to each corner
