This is an antique decorative whatnot. An English, mahogany and rosewood two tier Canterbury stand, dating to the Regency period, circa 1830.

- Enthusiastically decorated stand with beautiful finish
- Displays a desirable aged patina throughout
- Attractive stocks show fine grain interest
- Presents rich caramel hues beneath a wax polish finish
- Striking fretwork gallery creates a fascinating upstand with flowing foliate motif
- A quartet of dashing barley twist supports frame a well-lit under-tier
- Drawer to front concealed within the stout base, enclosed by stout block shoulders
 - Wonderfully gadrooned cups adorn the tapering legs, riding upon brass castors beneath

This is a striking antique decorative whatnot, a testament to the flourishes of Regency period craftsmanship. Solid joints and construction, delivered waxed, polished and ready for the home.
