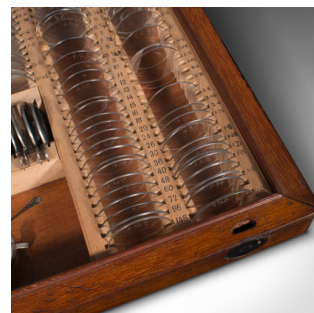


Antique Optometrist's Set, English, Optical Instrument Case, Victorian, C.1900
