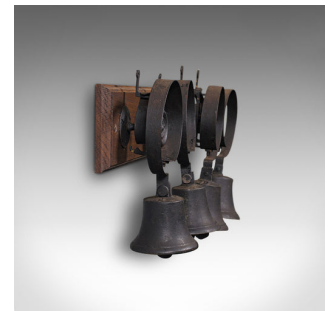


Set Of Antique Servant's Bells, English, Cast Iron, Oak, Butler, Victorian, 1860

This is a set of antique servant's bells. An English, cast iron butler's bell on an oak plinth, dating to the mid Victorian period, circa 1860.

- Fascinating set of bells, with decorative appeal

- With fine aged appearance, each bell hosts a different register for distinction
- Spiral arms rotate, creating an oscillation within the arms
- Circular mounts to each bell, two adorned with quarterfoil motif
- Pair of bells marked as a number 10, the other pair are a 12
- Mounted upon a quality oak plinth for ease of wall hanging
