- Accentuated with attractive gold tooling, the skiver of generous size
- Document slide nestled between the first and second drawer adds further versatility
- Each drawer dressed with brass drop handles upon shaped backplates
- Inset locks to each drawer - untested, keys absent
- Engraved to each lock for Hobbs & Co, the Anglo-American furniture specialist
