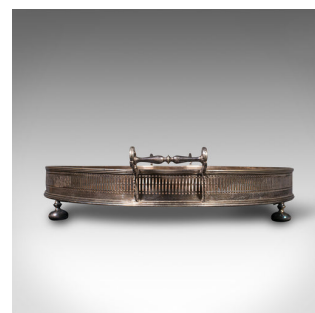


Antique Oval Serving Tray, English, Oak, Silver Plate, Tea Platter, Edwardian
