This is an antique 3 draw telescope. An English, enamelled brass 'The Sign Post' terrestrial refractor with compass by Lawrence & Days of London, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

Perfect for bird watching, landscape appreciation, wildlife stalking, or maritime observation. Equally suitable for observing the night sky.

- Displays a desirable aged patina throughout
- Enamelled brass draw tubes show deep black tones
- Machine textured primary tube a tactile delight
- Generously sized objective diameter of 40mm (1.5") with a clear, bright view
- Sliding sun shield with hinged compass dust cap
- Compass displays cardinal and inter-cardinal points
- Maker's mark to face reads 'Lawrence & Tayo, 67 Chancery Lane, London
- Flared rear eye-cup with sliding dust cover annotated with engraved focus marks
- Primary barrel engraved 'The Sign Post Lawrence & Damp; Mayo, London
