This is a large antique estate hunt cabinet of superior traditional craftsmanship. An English, carved oak mirror back sideboard, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Superior proportion to this Devonshire estate made cabinet
- Displays a desirable aged patina and presented in fine order
- Select oak shows fine grain interest throughout with enthusiastically carved scenes
- Deep russet hues beam beneath a wax polish finish
- Striking crown moulding adorned with carved frieze displaying wild creatures
- Galleried upper with tapering columns framing the trio of mirrors
- Wonderfully bevelled mirror plates with wonderfully minimal foxing
- Useful sideboard with generous top, sits ahead of a trio of frieze panels
- Trio of drawers dressed with brass drop handles over rectangle backplates
- Carved field panel doors, the central panel presents a fox in woodland
- Doors dressed with brass escutcheons with inset working locks – keys present
