This is an antique 3 draw telescope. An English, brass 'Day or Night' terrestrial or astronomical refractor, dating to the mid Victorian period, circa 1860.

Perfect for bird watching, landscape appreciation, wildlife, or maritime observation. Equally suitable for observing the night sky.

- Displaying a desirable aged patina, some light marks commensurate with use
- Fruitwood primary barrel shows rich russet hues and a lightly aged appearance

- Sun protection provided by a deep, sliding sun shade
- Flared eye cup benefits from a sliding type dust cover
- Draws with a pleasingly firm action
- Three draw tubes, showing signs of light polish and use
 - Inscribed 'Dolland London' – an anonymous manufacturer of the time, looking to trade off the infamous Dollond name
