- Usefully sized for ease of reading with a diameter of 13.5cm (5.25")

- Secondary hand can be set to show the change since the previous day
- Reads 'Aneroid Barometer, Made in England'
- Mounted upon a quality oak back plate with fine grain interest
- The plate presents rich caramel hues beneath the wax polish finish
- Dressed with a pair of mounting loops for ease of hanging
