This is a striking antique cocktail cabinet. An English, walnut sideboard cupboard in the Arts & Crafts taste and the manner of Liberty, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Fascinating trapezoid form to the breakfront lower cabinet, with a repeat of foliate motif
- Field panel cabinet doors dressed with inset, brass lined locks - keys absent
- Original ivy green velour interior to the upper cabinets a tactile treat
- Lower cabinet offers a wide, useful storage shelf with generous space above and below
- Distinctive pierced brass hinges and demi-lune piercing to legs adds further visual appeal
