This is an antique carved correspondence desk with hidden drawer. A Scottish, oak writing table, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1860.

- Superior quality desk with delightfully figured stocks and Gothic revival overtones
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Select oak shows fine grain interest and wisps of medullary rays
- Rich caramel hues beam beneath the wax polish finish
- Low back rest adorned with carved winged motif
- Upper console arranged with five drawers around a laptop friendly recess
- Writing surface decorated with leaf carved pattern edge
- Accessed by blind pulls, the writing surface extends by 9cm (3.5), with comfortable working height of 80.5cm (31.75")
- Desk base offers four drawers, each dressed with a circular pull
- Central desk dressed with an inset brass lined lock — key absent
- Right-hand drawer replete with concealed compartment to rear of box
