DESCRIPTION

This is a vintage 5' 6" tall decorative screen. A Japanese, hardwood and glass privacy or room divider with hand-painted panels, dating to the mid 20th century, circa 1950.

- Striking example of Japanese iconography
- Displays a desirable aged patina some marks commensurate with age
- Stout ebonised hardwood frame pleasingly heavy and robust
- Glass panels in very good order with clear, bright appearance
- Quartet of generously sized fabric scenes with hand-painted decoration
- Charming birds of paradise and storks presented upon a blush pink ground
- Cobalt blue ground to reverse accentuated with character marks and candle motif
- Gilt finished Greek key patterns contrast wonderfully against the black frame
- Of bi-fold form, the screen can fold flat in both directions or at right angles for room corners
 - Lower front panel replete with relief dragon figures in shimmering golden tones
 - Reverse presents an engraved and gilt finished mountain scene with pagoda and sail
