This is an antique showcase corner cabinet. A Dutch, satinwood bow-front display case, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1880.

- Of exemplary aesthetic appeal, with a striking finish and craftsmanship
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Select satinwood dazzles with fine grain interest and shimmering caramel hues
- Copious inlaid marquetry of boxwood and apple adds further distinction
- Fascinating hood shaped crown moulding accentuated with sea shell inlaid motif
- \bullet Tall glazed doors dressed with a brass foliate lock escutcheon in working order, key present
- Interior arranged as a pair of shelves, benefiting from the natural light cast by the clear, bright glass
 - Beautifully dressed with a later, soft olive velour interior lining
- \bullet Set within the bow form, three useful drawers to the mid point dressed with brass drop handles
- \bullet Pair of cabinet doors enhanced with large diamond lozenge inlays, secured by working lock
 - Contrasting borders of bird's eve maple a tasteful accourrement to the dashing
