This is an antique retailer's display cabinet. An English, mahogany and glass showcase dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Original glass in good order with light marks to top, commensurate with careful use
- Graced with slim pillars to maximise viewing within
- Sliding glazed doors to rear dressed with a pair of recessed brass pulls
- Wide glass shelf sits elegantly upon shaped bracket arms
- Shelf brackets adjustable in height, with a range of 53.5cm (21")
- Clear back helps light shine through the display case
- Display base dressed with a quality textile in a blue-grey hue
 - Deep front apron with moulded edge, continuing to the sides, raised upon a set of four block feet
