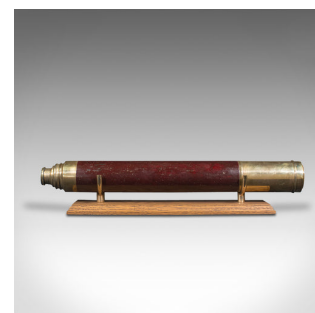
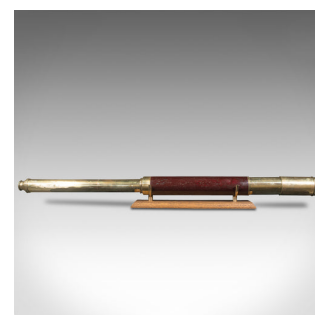


Antique Day or Night Telescope, English, Terrestrial, Henry Ward, Victorian
