This is a vintage tapestry. A French, needlepoint scene depicting The Lady and the Unicorn, dating to the late 20th century, circa 1980.

This delightful tapestry is a quality recreation of the 15th century renaissance series of tapestries known as Dame a la L'icorne (The Lady and the Unicorn). A series of six, this fascinating tapestry represents the central element of the whole - La Gout (The Sense of Taste).

- Displaying a desirably aged patina and in good order
- Quality needlepoint tapestry, issuing copious fascinations and in very good order
- Beautiful colour palette in shades of reds and blues a sight to behold
- The lady and her courtier sit between a lion and the titular unicorn
- Large fruiting trees, framed by heraldic flags stand within a bountiful garden
- Other small animals are present, the allegorical monkey experiencing the sense of taste from his stolen treat
- Dressed to the rear with five hanging loops for ease of wall display
