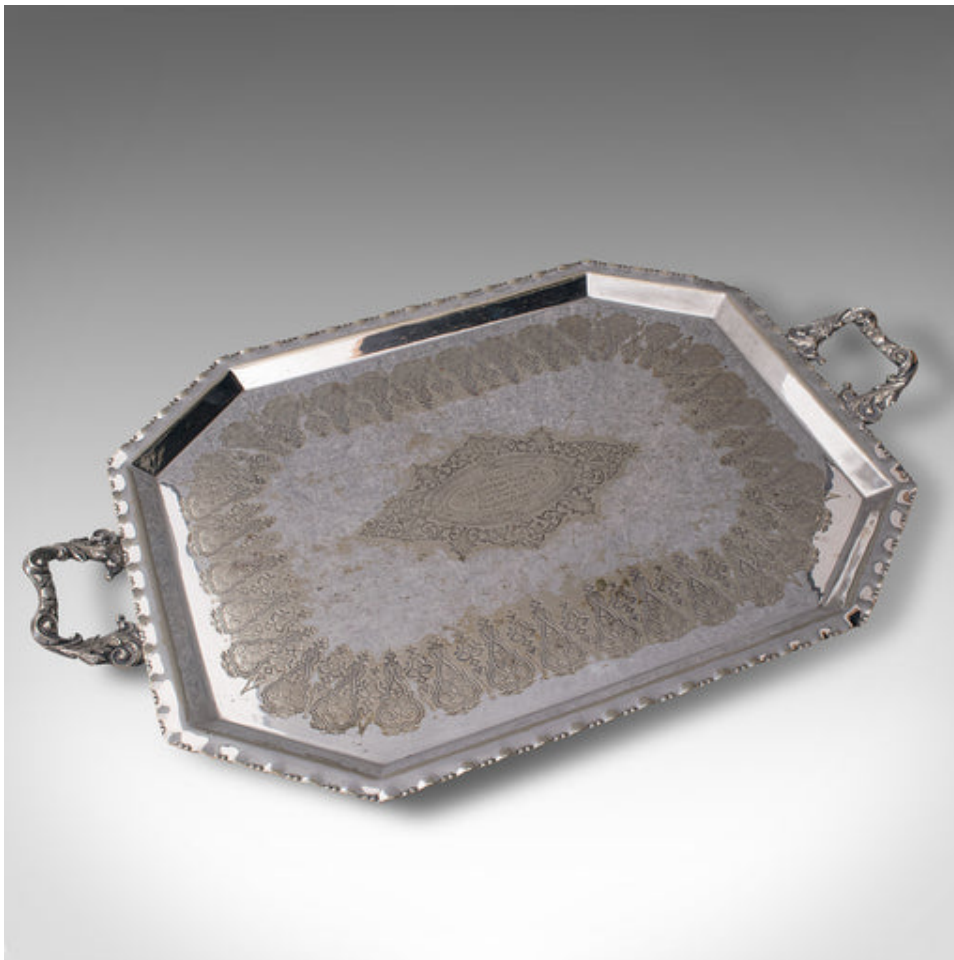


Antique Presentation Serving Tray, English, Silver Plated, Afternoon Tea, C.1895

  - Engraving reads '1st Prize, San Stefano Regatta, 5th September, 1897 - Gwyneth
  - Further personally engraved to a Stephen Nowill
  - Maker's marks to rear bear the Nowill name and D\* trademark for John Nowill of Sheffield
