This is an antique roll-over butter dish. An English, silver plated breakfast tureen or server, dating to the Victorian period and later, circa 1870.

- Striking dome topped serving dish with later ladle an admirable centrepiece
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Decades of sympathetic polishing offers a beautifully reflective quality to the silver plate
  - Engraved with a superb heraldic 'P' monogram to front of lid
- Fascinating dome lid retracts smoothly, nesting around itself distinctive lobe pull aids access
  - Cut-out for the ladle handle set within the trailing edge of the lid when closed
- $\bullet$  Removable butter tray with attractive pierced diamond shaped fretwork, sat upon a drip tray below

Ideal for keeping butter, sauces, heating peas or other vegetables

• Pair of ornate handles with a delightfully gadrooned finish
