This is an antique roll-over butter dish. An English, silver plated breakfast tureen or server, dating to the Victorian period and later, circa 1870.

- Decades of sympathetic polishing offers a beautifully reflective quality to the silver plate
- Engraved with a superb heraldic 'P' monogram to front of lid
- Fascinating dome lid retracts smoothly, nesting around itself - distinctive lobe pull aids access
- Cut-out for the ladle handle set within the trailing edge of the lid when closed
- Removable butter tray with attractive pierced diamond shaped fretwork, sat upon a drip tray below
