This is an antique campaign chair. A Chinese, carved mahogany folding colonial seat, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1850.

- Shield shaped seat pad with a wide, carved border adds further eye-catching detail
- \bullet X-frame legs articulate to folding position for ease of movement or storage
- Turned baluster stretchers uniting each leg, front and rear
