This is an antique portrait bust. An English, plaster head, signed by Francis Derwent Wood (1871-1926), dating to the early 20th century, circa 1920.

Francis Derwent Wood RA was a British sculptor. Elected to the Royal Academy in London in 1920, he also held a position as head of sculpture at the Royal College of Art between 1918 and 1923.

- Fascinating bust, personalised by a renowned British sculptor
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Quality plaster form with lightly glossed finish over caramel hues
- A rambunctious self portrait of the artist in his latter years, with overt character
- Personal inscription to front reads 'To R.E.K. from Derwent Wood' - signed to rear also
