This is an antique mayoral chair. An English, oak ecclesiastic armchair with Gothic Revival taste, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1880.

- A delight of strong Gothic overtones and Pugin-esque forms
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Quality oak stocks show fine grain interest and an abundance of medullary rays
- Presents rich caramel hues beneath a wax polish finish
- Upright, formal appearance, suited to grace high office
- Apex upper rail adorned with acanthus leaf carvings
- Medallion to centre with heraldic image over extended leaf forms
- Enthusiastically decorative backrest with circular arcade field panels
- Stout arms with highly distinctive leaf carved knuckles
- Raised upon stepped, arched supports
- Green leather seat cushion accentuated with brass press studs
