- Decorative borders abound, further graced by elegant shaped wings
- Dressed with six, prominent turned coat and hat rails of robust form

- Turned baluster supports with square sections to rear, surrounding a useful pair of stick stands
 - Removable drip trays to under tier provides drainage for umbrellas
