- Dial set behind a quality, thick glass plate with light blue tint
- Usefully sized for ease of reading at a glance, with a diameter of 14cm (5.5")

• Elegant annotations show the current weather condition, mirrored nicely upon the inner bezel

• Diamond turned secondary hand can be set to show the change since the previous day

- Mounted upon a quality oak back plate with fine grain interest
- The plate presents dark caramel hues beneath the wax polish finish
- Dressed with a pair of mounting loops for ease of hanging
