- United by lower galleried tier displaying typical geometric detail

The British Empire Exhibition was opened on St George's Day, 23 April 1924, by King Edward V and Queen Mary at the Empire Stadium, London. Running for 6 months in 1924 and again in 1925 it set out to showcase and explore trading opportunities.

This showpiece exhibit displaying quality craftsmanship, solid joints and construction.
