This is an antique demi-lune folding card table. An English, walnut and amboyna half-round games or side table, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1850.

- Striking and exceptional, a treat for any drawing room or club lounge
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Select walnut shows fine grain interest and warm caramel hues
- Inlaid amboyna with boxwood stringing a perfect contrast
- Beautifully figured d-shaped top ideal for central room or wall placement
- Fold-over top rotates smoothly through 90-degrees to reveal the generous playing surface
- Delightful inset cobalt blue baize ideal for four players, with a diameter of 77cm (30.25")
- Deep drum apron with beaded edge hosts a useful internal compartment
- Graceful quintet of turned baluster supports rising from a domed carved bulb
- Inset knees skilfully accentuated with oak leaf frieze
- Four decorated cabriole legs with scrolled oak leaf toes
